Rochester Map Adventure 2023


Sunday, June 4, 2023 at 11:00 AM 2 or 4 hours of adventure!

If this sounds like fun then why not plan to join the Rochester Orienteering Club for the tenth Rochester Map Adventure?

Entry fee is \$10 for individuals, and \$20 for teams of 2-4 people. (Additional \$5 for day-of-meet entries.)

Teams and individual hikers, bicyclists and runners will receive a detailed map of a large portion of the city including the South Wedge, downtown, Highland Park, Mt. Hope Cemetery, Corn Hill, the Park/East Avenue area, and the Neighborhood of the Arts. The maps will have circles drawn on them indicating the exact locations of the trivia points.

At each circle marked on the map, participants will have a question which can readily be answered by information visible.

Example questions from a previous event are shown on back.

In what year do records show Amos Burrows lived at 21 Savannah St?

Records show that in 1870, 74-year old Amos Burrows and his 63-year old wife Mary lived at 21 Savannah Street. Mr. Burrows was a grocer, who operated his business on the same site as his home, which was typical for the era. The Burrows home was removed in the 1950s during the construction of the Inner Loop.

Maps will be distributed 30 minutes prior to the start. There will be 2-hour and 4-hour time categories.

The teams with the most correct answers in the least amount of time will be the winners.
