# A-Meet, September 19-20 Mendon and Rattlesnake 

On September 19 \& 20, ROC will be hosting the United States Ultra Long and Sprint Championships.
On Saturday the competition will be at Mendon Ponds. In the morning starting at 10AM the Sprint will take place in the North Meadow area. A Sprint is a $12-15$ minute course (winning time) that puts a premium on fast running and quick thinking. It should also be a good spectator event because some of the controls will be out in the open and we will have a PA announcing the position of the runners at various points on the course.
After the Sprint there will a free lunch of bagels and fruit served at West Lodge. Starting at 1:30 PM the nonchampionship middle distance courses will open. Middle distance courses have short legs and generally take the winner 30-35 minutes to complete. These courses will be similar to most of our local meets and we will be using the West side of the park.
For the Saturday event at Mendon, there will also be Recreational courses available that you can sign up for starting at 1:00PM at West Lodge. The cost and the sign up will be the same as most ROC local meets. You can start anytime between 1:30 and 2:30PM. An ice cream social sponsored by the Junior Team will be offered at West Lodge from 4:00-5:00PM.

On Sunday everything moves down to our new map of Rattlesnake Hill Wildlife Management Area five miles West of Dansville. It is about a 45 -minute drive from Mendon Ponds.
We will park at the Ossian Community Center and ride buses up to the start area about three miles away. Ultra long courses are double the distance of normal courses so get good nights sleep if you plan to participate. These courses are not technically more difficult than our normal ROC courses, but they are longer. There is a special "short" Brown course for those who want a technical challenge without the extra distance.
All of the courses on Sunday require pre-registration and there will be no recreational or string $\boldsymbol{O}$ courses offered because of the special logistics. A local community group at the Ossian Community Center will offer soup, sandwiches and fruit from noon until 3:00 p.m.. NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO DRIVE THEIR CAR UP THE HILL DUE TO NYS DEC RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING.
It should be an enjoyable weekend so join the fun. You can get more information and register online (only up to September 10!) by going to the club website, roc.us.orienteering.org

## General information on local meets

## Courses

The club uses the USOF "color" designations wherever applicable. A description of the courses is as follows:

The White course is intended to be easy enough for first-time participants after a short introduction to the sport. Control points are generally on trails or similarly easy-to-locate features.

The Yellow course is slightly more difficult than the White course. Control points are generally placed close to but not right at easy-tofind features, such as on a knoll that is 50 m away from a trail junction.

The Orange course requires more map-reading and course-planning skills than the Yellow course. Controls will generally have a good attack point, but the attack point may be more subtle than on the Yellow course, or the control will be placed further from the attack point. The route choice from one control to the attack point for the next control is often less obvious than on the Yellow course.

The Brown, Green, Red, and Blue courses differ from each other only in length. At local parks, they are usually the most difficult course that can be set given the size and the terrain of the park. Map-reading, compass, and route-planning skills will be tested to a greater degree on this course.

Sometimes other courses may be offered, such as a Motala (a course which involves one or more map exchanges), or a Line-O or Score-O. These courses will be explained in the meet instructions at any meet that uses these formats.

## Entry fees

The entry fees to ROC meets are $\$ 3.00$ per individual or group for ROC members and $\$ 6.00$ for non-members. If several people (a family group for example) enter as a group using the same map, the fee is still $\$ 3.00$ (members) or $\$ 6.00$ (non-members). Additional maps are available for $\$ 1.00$ each. A person or group can do a second course using the same map for no additional charge (if you complete the White course and decide to try the Yellow course, for example).

## Beginner instruction

Beginners are always welcome; there is an informal beginners' clinic approximately 15 minutes after the beginning of the event, and all meets offer a course suitable for beginning orienteers.

## Club Series and Sprint Series update

As reported in the March newsletter, ROC this year has initiated two competitive series, the Club Series and the Sprint Series. There are five meets that were designated as Club Series events (conventional-length courses), and five other meets that were designated as Sprint Series events (courses much shorter than normal). There are age/gender categories, within which points would be awarded based on finishing order within that category.
For both the Club Series and the Sprint Series, the best four races will determine the winner in each of the classes. The scoring gives 10 points for first place, 9 for second and so on. (A perfect score for the series would be 40).
Anyone who works at a meet as either meet director or course setter receives points for that meet equal to the average point that he or she earned in the other races of that series.

Thus, if someone competes in 4 events, scoring 5, 7, and 9 points respectively for the three events, and is course setter for another event, that person would receive 7 points (the average of 5, 7, and 9) for the event that he or she was course setter for.

As of this writing, there have been 3 out of the 5 meets held in the Club Series, and 4 out of the 5 meets held in the Sprint series. A summary of series results to date is on the next page.

Cobb's Hill is a City of Rochester Park. There are wonderful views of the City for those who pause during their event. The White course featured flags on trails for first timers. The Yellow course
had flags near trails and took runners to many areas of the park. The Orange course featured flags as far from trails as possible. But in a small open park, that is not far. For those not satisfied by the Orange course, a Long Orange course was provided by adding a second Orange level map to the regular Orange.
